From 1 December 2025, all new accounts, orders, invoices, and payments will be managed through Specialised Pipe & Fittings Australia (SPFA). Updated account and remittance details will be provided closer to the transition date.

2. **Existing Orders and Contracts:**

All orders and contracts placed with Ozlinc before 28 November 2025 will be honoured and managed to completion by Ozlinc Industries Pty Ltd.

3. **Ozlinc Incoming Calls:**

OzlinCs' existing communication channels, phone and email, will remain active for a period of time. However, when you call the landline from 1st December, 2025, you will first hear a brief message explaining the recent change in the business structure and how it affects new enquiries and orders. After this message, your call will continue as normal and be directed to the appropriate team member for assistance.

4. **Ozlinc Email Communications:**

For transitioning Ozlinc employees, emails sent to their Ozlinc addresses from 1st December, 2025 will automatically be redirected to their new SPFA email. Our team will continue to respond promptly to all correspondence.
